## Offerings for the Sanctuary

25:1 THEN the LORD spoke to Moses, saying, 2 "a Tell the sons of Israel to ${ }^{1}$ raise a ${ }^{2}$ contribution for Me; ${ }^{\text {b }}$ from every man whose heart moves him you shall ${ }^{1}$ raise My ${ }^{2}$ contribution. 3 "And this is the ${ }^{1}$ contribution which you are to ${ }^{2}$ raise from them: gold, silver and bronze, $4{ }^{1}$ ablue, purple and scarlet material, fine linen, goat hair, 5 rams' skins dyed red, porpoise skins, acacia wood, $6^{\text {a }}$ oil for lighting, ${ }^{\mathrm{b}}$ spices for the anointing oil and for the fragrant incense, 7 onyx stones and setting stones, for the ${ }^{\text {a }}$ ephod and for
 among them. 9 "According to all that I am going to show you, as the pattern of the tabernacle and the pattern of all its furniture, just so you shall construct it.

## Ark of the Covenant

10 "a And they shall construct an ark of acacia wood two and a half ${ }^{1}$ cubits ${ }^{2}$ long, and one and a half cubits ${ }^{3}$ wide, and one and a half cubits ${ }^{4}$ high. 11 "And you shall ${ }^{\text {a }}$ overlay it with pure gold, inside and out you shall overlay it, and you shall make a gold molding ${ }^{1}$ around it. 12 "And you shall cast four gold rings for it, and ${ }^{1}$ fasten them on its four feet, and two rings shall be on one side of it and two rings on the other side of it. 13 "And you shall make poles of acacia wood and overlay them with gold. 14 "And you shall put the poles into the rings on the sides of the ark, to carry the ark with them. 15 "The apoles shall ${ }^{1}$ remain in the rings of the ark; they shall not be removed from it. 16 "And you shall ${ }^{\text {a }}$ put into the ark the testimony which I shall give you. 17 "And you shall a make a ${ }^{1}$ mercy seat of pure gold, two and a half ${ }^{2}$ cubits ${ }^{3}$ long and one and a half cubits ${ }^{4}$ wide. 18 "And you shall make two cherubim of gold, make them of hammered work ${ }^{1}$ at the two ends of the mercy seat. 19 "And make one cherub ${ }^{1}$ at one end and one cherub ${ }^{1}$ at the other end; you shall make the cherubim of one piece with the mercy seat at its two ends. 20 "And ${ }^{\text {a }}$ the cherubim shall have their wings spread upward, covering the mercy seat with their wings and ${ }^{1}$ facing one another; the faces of the cherubim are to be turned toward the mercy seat. 21 "And ${ }^{\text {a }}$ you shall put the mercy seat ${ }^{1}$ on top of the ark, and ${ }^{\text {b }}$ in the ark you shall put the testimony which I shall give to you. 22 "And ${ }^{\text {a there I will meet with you; }}$ and from above the mercy seat, from ${ }^{b}$ between the two cherubim which are upon the ark of the testimony, I will speak to you about all that I will give you in commandment for the sons of Israel.

## The Table of Showbread

23 "a And you shall make a table of acacia wood, two cubits ${ }^{1}$ long and one cubit ${ }^{2}$ wide and one and a half cubits ${ }^{3}$ high. 24 "And you shall overlay it with pure gold and make a gold "border around it. 25 "And you shall make for it a rim of a handbreadth around it; and you shall make a gold border for the rim around it. 26 "And you shall make four gold rings for it and put rings on the four corners which are on its four feet. 27 "The rings shall be close to the rim as holders for the poles to carry the table. 28 "And you shall make the poles of acacia wood and overlay them with gold, so that with them the table may be carried. 29 "And you shall make its ${ }^{1 \text { a }}$ dishes and its pans and its jars and its ${ }^{2}$ bowls, with which to pour libations; you shall make them of pure gold. 30 "And you shall set ${ }^{\text {a }}$ the
bread of the ${ }^{1}$ Presence on the table before $\mathrm{Me}^{2}$ at all times.

## The Golden Lampstand

31 "a Then you shall make a lampstand of pure gold. The lampstand and its base and its shaft are to be made of hammered work; its cups, its ${ }^{1}$ bulbs and its flowers shall be of one piece with it. 32 "And ${ }^{\text {a }}$ six branches shall go out from its sides; three branches of the lampstand from its one side, and three branches of the lampstand from its ${ }^{1}$ other side. 33 "a Three cups shall be shaped like almond blossoms in the one branch, a ${ }^{1}$ bulb and a flower, and three cups shaped like almond blossoms in the ${ }^{2}$ other branch, a ${ }^{1}$ bulb and a flower-so for six branches going out from the lampstand; 34 and ${ }^{\text {a }}$ in the lampstand four cups shaped like almond blossoms, its ${ }^{1}$ bulbs and its flowers. 35 "a And a ${ }^{1}$ bulb shall be under the first pair of branches coming out of it, and a ${ }^{1}$ bulb under the second pair of branches coming out of it, and a ${ }^{1}$ bulb under the third pair of branches coming out of it, for the six branches coming out of the lampstand. $36{ }^{\text {"a }}$ Their ${ }^{1}$ bulbs and their branches shall be of one piece with it; all of it shall be one piece of hammered work of pure gold. 37 "Then you shall make its lamps seven in number; and ${ }^{\text {athey shall }}{ }^{1}$ mount its lamps so as to shed light on the space in front of it. 38 "And its snuffers and ${ }^{1}$ their trays shall be of pure gold. 39 "It shall be made from a talent of pure gold, with all these utensils. 40 "And ${ }^{\text {a }}$ see that you make them ${ }^{\text {b }}$ after the pattern for them, which was shown to you on the mountain.
