1 Answer me when <sup>b</sup>I call, O God <sup>1</sup> of my righteousness! Thou hast <sup>2 c</sup>relieved me in my distress; Be <sup>d</sup>gracious to me and <sup>e</sup>hear my prayer.

**2** O sons of men, how long will <sup>a</sup>my <sup>1</sup>honor become <sup>b</sup>a reproach? How long will you love <sup>c</sup> what is worthless and aim at <sup>d</sup>deception? <sup>2</sup>[Selah].
