## PSALM 77

Comfort in Trouble from Recalling God's Mighty Deeds.

For the choir director; <sup>+</sup>according to Jeduthun. A Psalm of Asaph.

1 My voice *rises* to God, and I will <sup>a</sup>cry aloud; My voice *rises* to God, and He will hear me. 2 In the <sup>a</sup>day of my trouble I sought the Lord; <sup>b</sup>In the night my <sup>c</sup>hand was stretched out <sup>1</sup> without weariness; My soul <sup>d</sup>refused to be comforted. 3 When I remember God, then I am <sup>a</sup>disturbed; *When* I <sup>b</sup>sigh, then <sup>c</sup>my spirit grows faint. <sup>1</sup>[Selah]. 4 Thou hast held my eyelids *open*; I am so troubled that I <sup>a</sup>cannot speak. 5 I have considered the <sup>a</sup>days of old, The years of long ago. 6 I will remember my <sup>a</sup>song in the night; I <sup>b</sup>will meditate with my heart; And my spirit <sup>1</sup>ponders. 7 Will the Lord <sup>a</sup>reject forever? And will He<sup>b</sup>never be favorable again? 8 Has His <sup>a</sup>lovingkindness ceased forever? Has *His*<sup>1 b</sup> promise come to an end <sup>2</sup> forever? 9 Has God <sup>a</sup> forgotten to be gracious? Or has He in anger <sup>1</sup>withdrawn His <sup>b</sup>compassion?[Selah]. 10 Then I said, "<sup>a</sup>It is my <sup>1</sup>grief, That the <sup>b</sup>right hand of the Most High has changed." **11** I shall remember the <sup>a</sup>deeds of <sup>1</sup>the LORD; Surely I will <sup>a</sup>remember Thy wonders of old. 12 I will <sup>a</sup> meditate on all Thy work, And muse on Thy deeds. 13 Thy way, O God, is <sup>a</sup>holy; <sup>b</sup>What god is great like our God? 14 Thou art the <sup>a</sup>God who workest wonders; Thou hast <sup>b</sup>made known Thy strength among the peoples. 15 Thou hast by Thy <sup>1</sup> power <sup>a</sup>redeemed Thy people, The sons of Jacob and <sup>b</sup>Joseph.[Selah]. **16** The <sup>a</sup>waters saw Thee, O God; The waters saw Thee, they were in anguish; The deeps also trembled. 17 The <sup>a</sup>clouds poured out water;

The skies <sup>b</sup>gave forth a sound; Thy <sup>c</sup>arrows <sup>1</sup> flashed here and there.
18 The <sup>a</sup>sound of Thy thunder was in the whirlwind; The <sup>b</sup>lightnings lit up the world;
The <sup>c</sup>earth trembled and shook.
19 Thy <sup>a</sup>way was in the sea,
And Thy paths in the mighty waters, And Thy footprints may not be known.
20 Thou <sup>a</sup>didst lead Thy people like a flock, By the hand of <sup>b</sup>Moses and Aaron.
