## **PSALM 147**

Praise for Jerusalem's Restoration and Prosperity.

PRAISE <sup>2</sup>the LORD! For <sup>a</sup>it is good to sing praises to our God; For <sup>3</sup>it is pleasant *and* praise is <sup>b</sup>becoming. 2 The LORD <sup>a</sup>builds up Jerusalem; He<sup>b</sup>gathers the outcasts of Israel. 3 He heals the <sup>a</sup>brokenhearted, And <sup>b</sup>binds up their <sup>1</sup>wounds. 4 He <sup>a</sup>counts the number of the stars; He<sup>1 b</sup>gives names to all of them. 5 <sup>a</sup>Great is our Lord, and abundant in strength: His <sup>b</sup>understanding is <sup>1</sup>infinite. 6 The LORD <sup>1</sup> <sup>a</sup>supports the afflicted; He brings down the wicked to the ground. 7 <sup>a</sup>Sing to the LORD with thanksgiving; Sing praises to our God on the lyre, 8 Who <sup>a</sup>covers the heavens with clouds, Who <sup>b</sup>provides rain for the earth, Who <sup>c</sup> makes grass to <sup>1</sup> grow on the mountains. 9 He <sup>a</sup>gives to the beast its food, And to the <sup>b</sup>young ravens which cry. 10 He does not delight in the strength of the <sup>a</sup>horse; He <sup>b</sup>does not take pleasure in the legs of a man. 11 The LORD <sup>a</sup> favors those who fear Him, <sup>b</sup>Those who wait for His lovingkindness. 12 Praise the LORD, O Jerusalem! Praise your God, O Zion! 13 For He has strengthened the <sup>a</sup>bars of your gates; He has <sup>b</sup>blessed your sons within you.

14 He <sup>a</sup> makes <sup>1</sup> peace in your borders; He <sup>b</sup>satisfies you with <sup>c</sup>the <sup>2</sup> finest of the wheat.
15 He sends forth His <sup>a</sup>command to the earth; His <sup>b</sup>word runs very swiftly.
16 He gives <sup>a</sup>snow like wool; He scatters the <sup>b</sup>frost like ashes.
17 He casts forth His <sup>a</sup>ice as fragments; Who can stand before His <sup>b</sup>cold?
18 He <sup>a</sup>sends forth His word and melts them;

He <sup>b</sup>causes His wind to blow and the waters to flow.

19 He <sup>a</sup>declares His words to Jacob,

His <sup>b</sup>statutes and His ordinances to Israel. 20 He <sup>a</sup>has not dealt thus with any nation; And as for His ordinances, they have <sup>b</sup>not known them. <sup>1</sup>Praise <sup>2</sup>the LORD!
