## Prophecy against the Shepherds of Israel

34:1 Then the word of the Lord came to me saying, 2 "Son of man, prophesy against the ashepherds of Israel. Prophesy and say to those shepherds, 'Thus says the Lord God, "Woe, shepherds of Israel who have been been been the feeding themselves! Should not the shepherds cfeed the flock? 3 "You at the fat and clothe yourselves with the wool, you slaughter the fat *sheep* without feeding the flock. 4 "Those who are sickly you have not strengthened, the diseased you have not healed, the broken you have not bound up, the scattered you have not brought back, nor have you sought for the lost; but with force and with severity you have dominated them. 5 "And they were ascattered for lack of a shepherd, and they became food for every beast of the field and were scattered. 6 "My flock awandered through all the mountains and on every high hill, and My flock was scattered over all the surface of the earth; and there was no one to search or seek *for* them.""

7 Therefore, you shepherds, hear the word of the LORD: 8 "As I live," declares the Lord GOD, "surely because My flockhas become a aprey, My flock has even become food for all the beasts of the field for lack of a shepherd, and My shepherds did not search for My flock, but *rather* the shepherds fed themselves and did not feed My flock; 9 therefore, you shepherds, hear the word of the LORD: 10 'Thus says the Lord GOD, "Behold, I am against the shepherds, and I shall demand My sheep from them and make them becase from feeding sheep. So the shepherds will not feed themselves anymore, but I shall cheliver My flock from their mouth, that they may not be food for them.""

## The Restoration of Israel

11 For thus says the Lord GOD, "Behold, I Myself will asearch for My sheep and seek them out. 12 "As a shepherd cares for his herd in the day when he is among his scattered sheep, so I will bcare for My sheep and will deliver them from all the places to which they were scattered on a cloudy and gloomy day. 13 "And I will bring them out from the peoples and gather them from the countries and bring them to their own land; and I will feed them on the mountains of Israel, by the streams, and in all the inhabited places of the land. 14 "I will feed them in a good pasture, and their grazing ground will be on the mountain heights of Israel. There they will lie down in good grazing ground, and they will feed in brich pasture on the mountains of Israel. 15 "I will feed My flock and I will lead them to rest," declares the Lord GOD. 16 "I will seek the lost, bring back the scattered, bind up the broken, and strengthen the sick; but the fat and the strong I will destroy. I will feed them with judgment.

17 "And as for you, My flock, thus says the Lord GOD, 'Behold, I will a judge between one 1 sheep and another, between the rams and the male goats. 18 'Is it too a slight a thing for you that you should feed in the good pasture, that you must tread down with your feet the rest of your pastures? Or that you should drink of the clear waters, that you must 1 foul the rest with your feet? 19 'And as for My flock, they must eat what you tread down with your feet, and they must drink what you 1 foul with your feet!"

**20** Therefore, thus says the Lord GOD to them, "Behold, I, even I, will judge between the fat sheep and the lean sheep. 21 "Because you push with side and with shoulder, and athrust at all the <sup>1</sup>weak with your horns, until you have scattered them <sup>2</sup>abroad, 22

therefore, I will adeliver My flock, and they will no longer be a prey; and I will judge between one sheep and another. 23 "Then I will aset over them one bshepherd, My servant <sup>c</sup>David, and he will feed them; he will feed them himself and be their shepherd. 24 "And I, the LORD, will be their God, and My servant <sup>a</sup>David will be prince among them; I, the LORD, have spoken.

25 "And I will make a acovenant of peace with them and beliminate harmful beasts from the land, so that they may clive securely in the wilderness and sleep in the woods. 26 "And I will make them and the places around My hill a ablessing. And I will cause bshowers to come down in their season; they will be showers of blessing. 27 "Also the tree of the field will yield its fruit, and the earth will yield its increase, and they will be <sup>a</sup>secure on their land. Then they will know that I am the LORD, when I have <sup>b</sup>broken the bars of their yoke and have delivered them from the hand of those who enslaved them. 28 "And they will no longer be a prey to the nations, and the beasts of the earth will not devour them; but they will alive securely, and no one will make them afraid. 29 "And I will establish for them a arenowned planting place, and they will bnot again be victims of famine in the land, and they will not <sup>c</sup>endure the insults of the nations anymore. 30 "Then they will know that <sup>a</sup>I, the LORD their God, am with them, and that they, the house of Israel, are My people," declares the Lord God. 31 "As for you, My asheep, the behavior of My pasture, you are men, and I am your God," declares the Lord GoD.
