Shall I present my <sup>b</sup>first-born *for* my rebellious acts, The fruit of my body for the sin of my soul? 8 He has <sup>a</sup>told you, O man, what is good; And <sup>b</sup>what does the LORD require of you But to <sup>c</sup>do justice, to <sup>d</sup>love <sup>1</sup>kindness, And to walk <sup>2</sup> <sup>e</sup>humbly with your God? 9 The voice of the LORD will call to the city— And it is sound wisdom to fear Thy name: "Hear, O tribe.
