The Day of Pentecost

2:1 And when athe day of Pentecost had come, they were all together in one place. 2 And suddenly there came from heaven a noise like a violent, rushing wind, and it filled athe whole house where they were sitting. 3 And there appeared to them tongues as of fire distributing themselves, and they are sted on each one of them. 4 And they were all afilled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak with other tongues, as the Spirit was giving them utterance.

5 Now there were Jews living in Jerusalem, "devout men, from every nation under heaven. 6 And when "this sound occurred, the multitude came together, and were bewildered, because they were each one hearing them speak in his own ¹language. 7 And "they were amazed and marveled, saying, "¹Why, are not all these who are speaking "Galileans? 8 "And how is it that we each hear *them* in our own ¹language ²to which we were born? 9 "Parthians and Medes and Elamites, and residents of Mesopotamia, Judea and "Cappadocia, "Pontus and ¹ CAsia, 10 "Phrygia and "Pamphylia, Egypt and the districts of Libya around "Cyrene, and ¹ dvisitors from Rome, both Jews and ² proselytes, 11 Cretans and Arabs—we hear them in our *own* tongues speaking of the mighty deeds of God." 12 And "they all continued in amazement and great perplexity, saying to one another, "What does this mean?" 13 But others were mocking and saying, "a They are full of ¹ sweet wine."

Peter's Sermon

14 But Peter, ¹taking his stand with ^athe eleven, raised his voice and declared to them: "Men of Judea, and all you who live in Jerusalem, let this be known to you, and give heed to my words. 15 "For these men are not drunk, as you suppose, ^afor it is *only* the ¹third hour of the day; 16 but this is what was spoken of through the prophet Joel:

17 "AND IT SHALL BE IN THE LAST DAYS," G od says, "THAT I WILL POUR FORTH OF MY SPIRIT UPON ALL ¹MANKIND;

AND YOUR SONS AND YOUR DAUGHTERS SHALL PROPHESY,

AND YOUR YOUNG MEN SHALL SEE VISIONS.

AND YOUR OLD MEN SHALL DREAM DREAMS;

18 EVEN UPON MY BONDSLAVES, BOTH MEN AND WOMEN, I WILL IN THOSE DAYS POUR FORTH OF MY SPIRIT

And they shall prophesy.

19 'AND I WILL GRANT WONDERS IN THE SKY ABOVE,

AND SIGNS ON THE EARTH BENEATH,

BLOOD, AND FIRE, AND VAPOR OF SMOKE.

20 'THE SUN SHALL BE TURNED INTO DARKNESS,

AND THE MOON INTO BLOOD,

BEFORE THE GREAT AND GLORIOUS DAY OF THE LORD SHALL COME.

- **22** "Men of Israel, listen to these words: ^aJesus the Nazarene, ^ba man ¹attested to you by God with ²miracles and ^cwonders and ³signs which God performed through Him in

your midst, just as you yourselves know— 23 this *Man*, delivered up by the apredetermined plan and foreknowledge of God, byou nailed to a cross by the hands of godless men and put *Him* to death. 24 "And God raised Him up again, putting an end to the agony of death, since it was impossible for Him to be held in its power. 25 "For David says of Him,

"I WAS ALWAYS BEHOLDING THE LORD IN MY PRESENCE; FOR HE IS AT MY RIGHT HAND, THAT I MAY NOT BE SHAKEN.

- 26 'THEREFORE MY HEART WAS GLAD AND MY TONGUE EXULTED; MOREOVER MY FLESH ALSO WILL ABIDE IN HOPE;
- 27 BECAUSE THOU WILT NOT ABANDON MY SOUL TO ^aHADES, ^bNor ¹ALLOW THY ²HOLY ONE TO ³UNDERGO DECAY.
- 28 'THOU HAST MADE KNOWN TO ME THE WAYS OF LIFE; THOU WILT MAKE ME FULL OF GLADNESS WITH THY PRESENCE.'
- 29 "¹Brethren, I may confidently say to you regarding the ^apatriarch David that he both ^bdied and ^c was buried, and ^dhis tomb is ²with us to this day. 30 "And so, because he was ^aa prophet, and knew that ^bGOD HAD SWORN TO HIM WITH AN OATH TO SEAT *one* ¹OF HIS DESCENDANTS UPON HIS THRONE, 31 he looked ahead and spoke of the resurrection of ¹the Christ, that ^aHE WAS NEITHER ABANDONED TO HADES, NOR DID His flesh ²SUFFER DECAY. 32 "This Jesus ^aGod raised up again, to which we are all ^bwitnesses. 33 "Therefore having been exalted ¹ ^ato the right hand of God, and ^bhaving received from the Father ^cthe promise of the Holy Spirit, He has ^dpoured forth this which you both see and hear. 34 "For it was not David who ascended into ¹heaven, but he himself says:

"THE LORD SAID TO MY LORD, "SIT AT MY RIGHT HAND,

35 Until I make Thine enemies a footstool for Thy feet." 36 "Therefore let all the ahouse of Israel know for certain that God has made Him both bLord and $^{\rm I}$ Christ—this Jesus whom you crucified."

The Ingathering

37 Now when they heard *this*, they were ¹pierced to the heart, and said to Peter and the rest of the apostles, "²Brethren, ^awhat shall we do?" 38 And Peter *said* to them, "^aRepent, and let each of you be ^bbaptized in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins; and you shall receive the gift of the Holy Spirit. 39 "For ^athe promise is for you and your children, and for all who are ^bfar off, as many as the Lord our God shall call to Himself." 40 And with many other words he solemnly ^atestified and kept on exhorting them, saying, "¹Be saved from this ^bperverse generation!" 41 So then, those who had received his word were baptized; and there were added that day about three thousand ¹ ^asouls. 42 And they were ^acontinually devoting themselves to the apostles' teaching and to fellowship, to ^bthe breaking of bread and ¹ ^ato prayer.

43 And ¹everyone kept feeling a sense of awe; and many ^awonders and ²signs were taking place through the apostles³. 44 And all those who had believed ¹were together, and ^ahad all things in common; 45 and they ^abegan selling their property and possessions, and were sharing them with all, as anyone might have need. 46 ^aAnd day by day continuing with one mind in the temple, and ^bbreaking bread ¹ from house to house, they were taking their ²meals together with gladness and ³sincerity of heart, 47 praising God, and ^ahaving favor with all the people. And the Lord ^bwas adding ¹to their number day by day ^cthose who were being saved.
