"Difficult Times Will Come"

3:1 But realize this, that ^a in the last days difficult times will come. 2 For men will be ^alovers of self, ^blovers of money, ^cboastful, ^carrogant, ^drevilers, ^cdisobedient to parents, ^eungrateful, ^funholy, 3 ^aunloving, irreconcilable, ^bmalicious gossips, without self-control, brutal, ¹ ^chaters of good, 4 ^atreacherous, ^breckless, ^cconceited, ^dlovers of pleasure rather than lovers of God; 5 holding to a form of ^{1 a}godliness, although they have ^bdenied its power; and ^cavoid such men as these. 6 For among them are those who ¹ ^aenter into households and captivate ^bweak women weighed down with sins, led on by ^cvarious impulses, 7 always learning and never able to ^acome to the ¹knowledge of the truth. 8 And just as ^aJannes and Jambres ^bopposed Moses, so these *men* also oppose the truth, ^cmen of depraved mind, rejected as regards the faith. 9 But they will not make further progress; for their ^a folly will be obvious to all, ^bas also that of those *two* came to be. 10 But you ^a followed my teaching, conduct, purpose, faith, patience, ^blove, ¹perseverance, 11 ^apersecutions, and ^bsufferings, such as happened to me at ^cAntioch, at ^dIconium and at ^eLystra; what ^f persecutions I endured, and out of them all ^g the Lord delivered me! 12 And indeed, all who desire to live godly in Christ Jesus ^a will be persecuted. 13 But evil men and impostors ^a will proceed *from bad* to worse, ^b deceiving and being deceived. 14 You, however, ^acontinue in the things you have learned and become convinced of, knowing from whom you have learned *them*; 15 and that ^a from childhood you have known ^b the sacred writings which are able to ^cgive you the wisdom that leads to ^dsalvation through faith which is in ^eChrist Jesus. 16 ^{1 a}All Scripture is ²inspired by God and profitable for teaching, for reproof, for correction, for ³training in righteousness; 17 that ^athe man of God may be adequate, ^bequipped for every good work.
