Things to Avoid

4:1 What is the source of quarrels and aconflicts among you? Is not the source your pleasures that wage bwar in your members? 2 You lust and do not have; so you acommit murder. And you are envious and cannot obtain; so you fight and quarrel. You do not have because you do not ask. 3 You ask and ado not receive, because you ask with wrong motives, so that you may spend it on your pleasures. 4 You adulteresses, do you not know that friendship with the world is chostility toward God? Therefore whoever wishes to be a friend of the world makes himself an enemy of God. 5 Or do you think that the Scripture speaks to no purpose: "He jealously desires the Spirit which He has made to dwell in us"? 6 But He gives a greater grace. Therefore it says, "bGod is opposed to the Proud, but Gives grace to the Humble." 7 Submit therefore to God. Resist the devil and he will flee from you. 8 Draw near to God and He will draw near to you. Cleanse your hands, you sinners; and cpurify your hearts, you double-minded. 9 Be miserable and mourn and weep; let your laughter be turned into mourning, and your joy to gloom. 10 Humble yourselves in the presence of the Lord, and He will exalt you.

11 ^aDo not speak against one another, ^bbrethren. He who speaks against a brother, or ^cjudges his brother, speaks against ^dthe law, and judges the law; but if you judge the law, you are not ^ea doer of the law, but a judge *of* it. 12 There is *only* one ^aLawgiver and Judge, the One who is ^bable to save and to destroy; but ^cwho are you who judge your neighbor?

13 ^aCome now, you who say, "^bToday or tomorrow, we shall go to such and such a city, and spend a year there and engage in business and make a profit." 14 ¹Yet you do not know ²what your life will be like tomorrow. ^aYou are *just* a vapor that appears for a little while and then vanishes away. 15 ¹Instead, *you ought* to say, "^aIf the Lord wills, we shall live and also do this or that." 16 But as it is, you boast in your ¹arrogance; ^aall such boasting is evil. 17 Therefore, ^ato one who knows *the* ¹right thing to do, and does not do it, to him it is sin.
