## THE FIRST EPISTLE OF JOHN

## *Introduction—The Incarnate Word*

1:1 What was afrom the beginning, what we have bheard, what we have cseen with our eyes, what we beheld and our hands handled, concerning the Word of Life—2 and the life was manifested, and we have bseen and bear witness and proclaim to you the eternal life, which was with the Father and was manifested to us—3 what we have seen and heard we proclaim to you also, that you also may have fellowship with us; and indeed our fellowship is with the Father, and with His Son Jesus Christ. 4 And these things we write, so that our bjoy may be made complete.

## God Is Light

**5** And <sup>a</sup>this is the message we have heard from Him and announce to you, that <sup>b</sup>God is light, and in Him there is no darkness at all. 6 <sup>a</sup>If we say that we have fellowship with Him and *yet* walk in the darkness, we <sup>b</sup>lie and <sup>c</sup>do not practice the truth; 7 but if we <sup>a</sup>walk in the light as <sup>b</sup>He Himself is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and <sup>c</sup>the blood of Jesus His Son cleanses us from all sin. 8 <sup>a</sup>If we say that we have no sin, we are deceiving ourselves, and the <sup>b</sup>truth is not in us. 9 <sup>a</sup>If we confess our sins, He is faithful and righteous to forgive us our sins and <sup>b</sup>to cleanse us from all unrighteousness. 10 <sup>a</sup>If we say that we have not sinned, we <sup>b</sup>make Him a liar, and <sup>c</sup>His word is not in us.
